Working closely with the Director of Programs, Board of Directors, and an engaged group of StartingBloc alumni, the Executive Director will have primary responsibility for all management and leadership functions, including fundraising and partnership-building, strategic planning, financial management, infrastructure and growth development, board of directors' development, as well as programmatic impact.

Responsibilities:

- Provide overall strategic leadership and tactical implementation for organizational strategy development, programmatic growth and quality, fundraising and financial management, and infrastructure development
- Work with the Board of Directors to create the organization's strategic plan and operational goals
- Develop and implement a fundraising strategy that incorporates grant writing, corporate sponsorships, major donor cultivation and solicitation, revenue-generating programs, and annual campaigns
- Create and carry out an infrastructure development plan that will support StartingBloc's future expansion
- Lead and oversee day-to-day organizational and programmatic management while providing a meaningful strategic plan that balances the internal and external needs of the organization
- Support and work with the Director of Programs to ensure that existing programs are fiscally sound and expand into new markets; as well as develop new programs that complement the organization's mission
- Build and maintain strong relationships with key stakeholders, including funders, fellows, alumni and partners, including establishing new partnerships with key corporations, nonprofits, and government offices
- Create and manage the organizational public face from maintaining its brand to key press engagements
- Ensure that all stakeholders share the organization's vision by strategically engaging and championing StartingBloc Fellows and partners
